Winner of the Pulitzer Prize in History, *Mary Chesnut's Civil War* presents the diary entries of Mary Chesnut, a self-proclaimed abolitionist married to a high-ranking member of the Confederate government. *The Private Mary Chesnut* is a more intimate and spontaneous version of the diaries. Entries are in their original form with none of the "corrections" (deletions of the most personal passages and the added elaborations of characters and events) that were made by Mary Chesnut before her death.

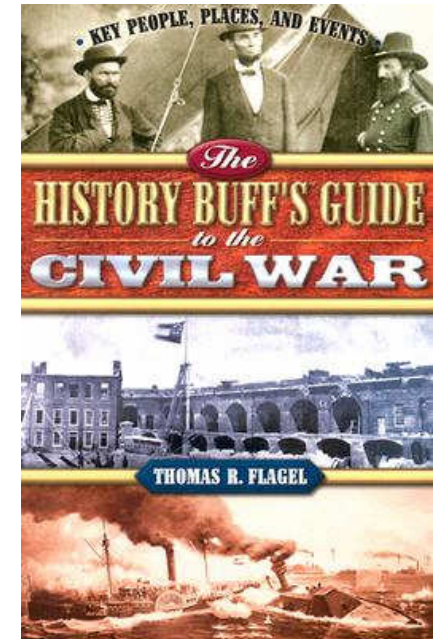
The library is free. You can find everything from fun books for kids and adults to in-depth research materials. We can even access library collections around the country using our Interlibrary Loan network.

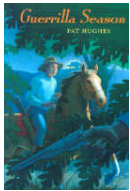

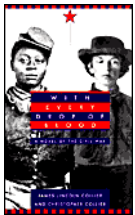
